



PUBLIC NOTICE 2012-09

Re: Application for Class License

May 24th, 2012

WHEREAS Servisair TCI Ltd. has submitted an application for a Class Spectrum License to operate an Aeronautical (ground-to-ground) base radio on UHF 461.325MHz, 461.425MHz and (ground-to-air) on VHF130.325 frequency in Providenciales, Turks and Caicos Islands.

On May 11, 2012, Air Turks & Caicos (2003) Ltd. filed an objection to the Commission's Public Notice 2012-04, published in the Gazette Vol. 163 No.17 dated April 20, 2012, objecting to Servisair application for the use of VHF 130.325MHz; stating that 103.325MHz is being utilized by Flight Support Ltd. on the authority of the TCI Government Ministry predating the TCI Telecommunications Commission establishment.

On May 17th 2012, the Commission reviewed Servisair applications and Air Turks & Caicos (2003) Ltd. objection, and allocates VHF 129.850MHz for Servisair TCI Ltd. operations.

NOW THEREFORE the Commission provides the following particulars:

1. The Commission is of the view that this transaction requires approval pursuant to Part IV Section 32 of the Telecommunications Ordinance (Ordinance 12 of 2004).
2. The proposed applicant is not Telecommunications Commission's Licensee.

ACCORDINGLY, the Commission hereby advises that this application is available at our Office for Public Scrutiny, and requests that any party having any comments, to make their views known in writing within **21** days of the publication of this notice in the gazette.
