



DECISION NOTICE 2016-2

Re: Approval of Transfer of Ownership and Control of Cable & Wireless (TCI) Limited

The request for approval to transfer ownership and control of Cable and Wireless (TCI) Limited (“CWTCI”) and Columbus Networks Ltd (“CNL”) from Cable and Wireless Communications plc (“CWC”) to Liberty Global plc (“Liberty Global”) has been approved.

Background:

On February 2, 2016, the Telecommunications Commission (“Commission”) received a request from Griffiths and Partners Attorneys, on behalf of CWTCI and CNL for approval, pursuant to the terms of the Licences or Turks and Caicos law, for the indirect transfer of control of CWTCI and CNL from CWC to Liberty Global. No Belonger-controlled shares were affected by the transfer.

Commission Decision

Based upon the information contained in the application of February 2, 2016, the Commission is satisfied that (i) no Belonger holdings will be affected; (ii) the transaction will not result in any adverse effect on competition in the supply of international wholesale capacity in the Turks and Caicos Islands; (iii) Liberty Global is financially and technically competent, and (iv) the acquisition satisfies the conditions required in the Ordinance. The Commission has therefore determined that the application is approved as filed.
