ViaSat, Inc. Application for Spectrum Licence

ViaSat, Inc., a U.S.-based global satellite broadband service operator, has submitted an application for a telecommunication license to provide satellite internet services to foreign-registered aircrafts and marine vessels traversing the Turks and Caicos Islands' air and marine spaces, to facilitate port-to-port and pier-to-pier broadband internet connectivity to its onboard passengers. The service is intended to be delivered using the following Ka-band frequencies below:

17.7 - 20.2 GHz (Downlink)

27.5 - 30 GHz (Uplink)

The Commission provides the following particulars:

1. The Commission is of the view that this transaction requires approval pursuant to Part IV Section 33 of the Chapter 14.02 Telecommunications Ordinance (2018).
2. The proposed applicant is not Telecommunications Commission's Licensee.
