Re: TCIG Department of Disaster Management -Application for Additional Spectrum

TCIG Department of Disaster Management has submitted an application for modification to its Spectrum Licence (NSL-0008VS-1-14) for additional frequencies to ensure the continuous operation of its VSAT services which provides critical geological information affecting the Turks and Caicos Islands and the wider Caribbean region. The frequencies that be used in conjunction with this service are as followed:

| 14.42029 (Earth-to-Space) | 290 |
