Re: Starlink Caribbean, LLC

Application for Internet Service Provider Licence

Starlink Caribbean, LLC has applied to the Telecommunications Commission for an Internet Service Provider Licence, to offer high-speed internet services across the Turks and Caicos Islands using satellite communications. The proposed service aims to provide connectivity with end user terminals on land, maritime, and aerial platforms and will utilize spectrum in the Ku-band for this purpose, on a shared basis, as listed below:

FREQUENCY	BANDWIDTH	USE
10.7 - 12.7 GHz	2000 MHz	User Terminal Downlink (Space-to-Earth)
14.0 - 14.5 GHz	500 MHz	User Terminal Uplink (Earth-to-Space)

The Commission provides the following particulars:

1. The Commission is of the view that this transaction requires approval pursuant to Part III & IV of the Chapter 14.02 Telecommunications Ordinance (2021).
2. The proposed applicant is not Telecommunications Commission's Licencee.
