Re: Bandpass Filter Requirements for FM Radio Stations

The Turks and Caicos Islands Telecommunications Commission (TCTC) today announced new requirements for all FM radio broadcasters to install and maintain bandpass cavity filters on their transmission systems. The measure, effective immediately, is designed to reduce harmful interference, protect critical communication services, and promote sustainable use of the FM spectrum.

The policy applies to all current FM broadcasters and new applicants seeking licenses to operate within the 88–108 MHz band. Existing operators will have an 18-month grace period to comply, while new applicants must demonstrate compliance as part of their technical submissions.
