### **Re: Interhealth Canada - Replacement frequencies**

Interhealth Canada has submitted an application to the Telecommunications Commission for radio spectrum to support private two-way radiocommunications at its hospital facilities in Grand Turk and Providenciales. Due to conflicts with existing frequency channel usage, the Commission is proposing the assignment of the following replacement frequencies to support operations at the Grand Turk (CTMC) Hospital:

- 463.6000 MHz @ 12.5 kHz
- 463.6125 MHz @ 12.5 kHz

The Commission provides the following particulars:

1. The Commission is of the view that this transaction requires approval pursuant to Part III & IV of the Chapter 14.02 Telecommunications Ordinance (2021).
2. The proposed applicant is Telecommunications Commission's Licensee.

The Commission hereby advises that the above application is available at our Office for Public Scrutiny and requests that any party having any comments, make their views known in writing within 21 days of the publication of this notice in the gazette.
